#### Tuesday 24th November 2020 Personal Development Day

We are delighted to be ale to continue with our Personal Development provision despite the difficulties presented by COVID restrictions. Our next PD Afternoon is on **Tuesday 24th Nov.** 

The students will be following a programme of activities covering the following topics which complement their PD curriculum.
