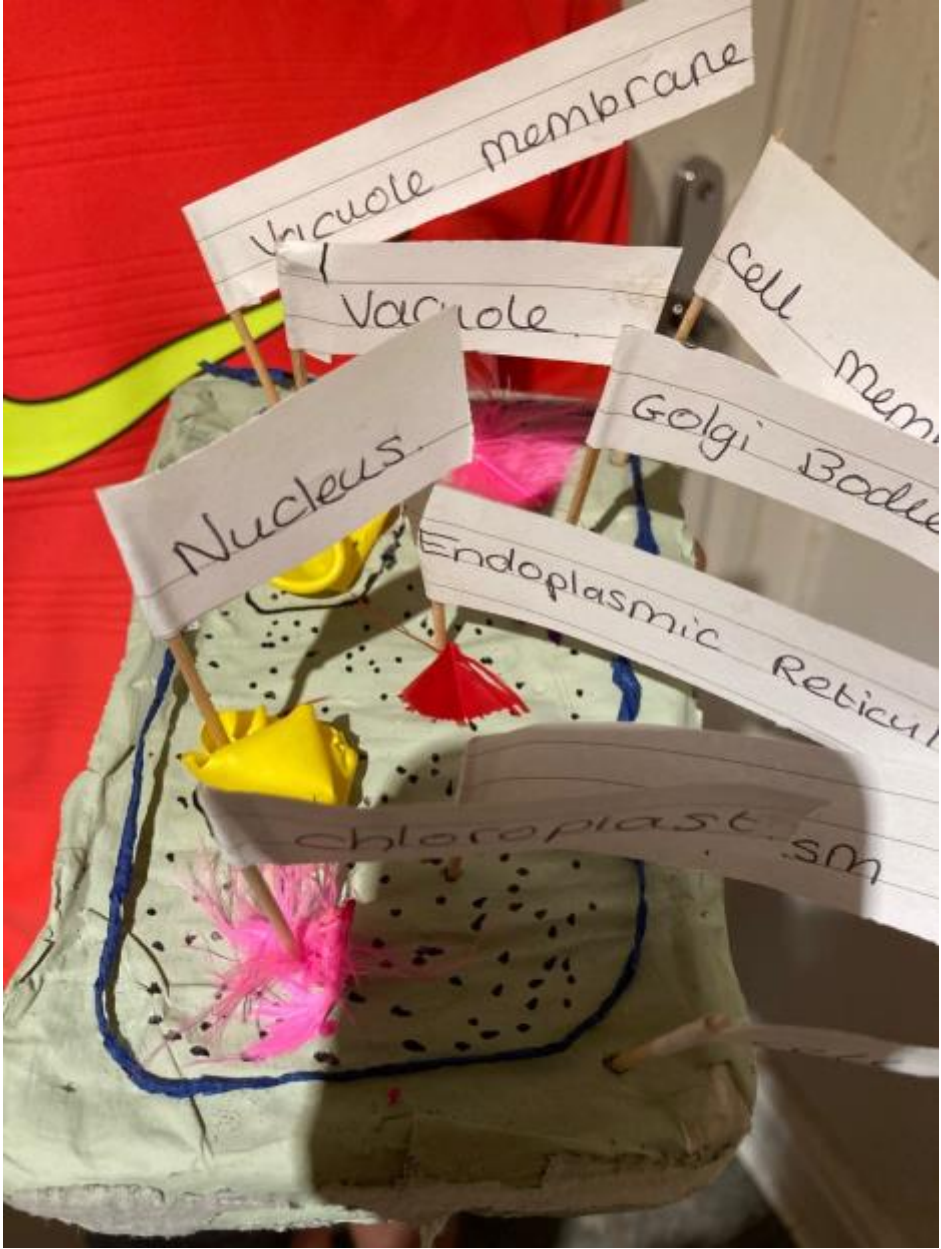
Park Family in the news- Year 7 Biology
