Covid 19

- Student self isolation period can end **if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6**, they can return to school on day 6. Please note the **first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period**, and the **second must be taken the following day**. All test results should be reported to the [NHS Test and Trace](#) and to school on [Report student Covid home testing results to school](#)

- Fully vaccinated individuals, children and young people aged between 5 and 18 years, identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19, should take an LFD test every day for seven days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result or develop symptoms at any time.”

- **COVID-19 lateral flow testing at home will continue twice weekly until further notice.**
