## Covid 19

- Statutory guidance on the wearing of face coverings in communal areas and classrooms has now been lifted. We, however, welcome anyone's decision to continue with the wearing of face coverings and fully support everyone's individual decisions.
- Student self isolation period can end **if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6**, they can return to school on day 6. Please note the **first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period**, and the **second must be taken the following day**. All test results should be reported to the [NHS Test and Trace](#) and to school on [Report student Covid home testing results to school](#)
- Fully vaccinated individuals, children and young people aged between 5 and 18 years, identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19, should take an LFD test every day for seven days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result or develop symptoms at any time."

- **COVID-19 lateral flow testing at home will continue twice weekly until further notice.**

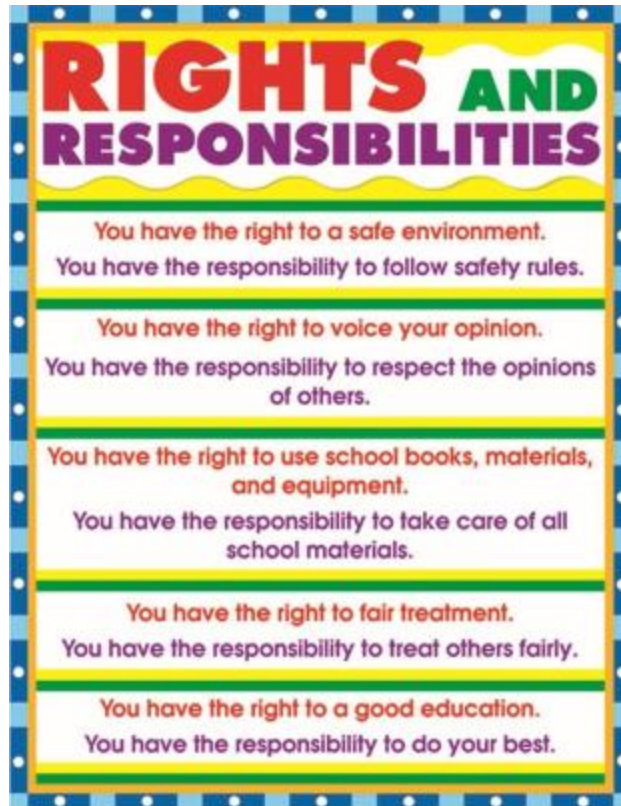
**prohibition (noun)** – a rule or law forbidding something.  
**surveillance (noun)** – the careful watching of someone, especially by an organization such as the police or the army.  
**intrusion (noun)** – the act of wrongfully entering someone else's property. *(Tier 2 language)*  
**intrusion (geology)** – the action or process of forcing a body of igneous rock between or through existing formations, without reaching the surface. *(Tier 3 language)*

• **The right to life:** protects your life, by law. The State is required to investigate suspicious deaths and deaths in custody.

• **The prohibition of torture and inhuman treatment:** you should never be tortured or treated in an inhuman or degrading way, no matter what the situation.

• **Protection against slavery and forced labour:** you should not be treated like a slave or subjected to forced labour.

• **The right to liberty and freedom:** you have the right to be free and the State can only imprison you with very good reason – for example, if you are convicted of a crime.

• **The right to a fair trial and no punishment without law:** you are innocent until proven guilty. If accused of a crime, you have the right to hear the evidence against you in a court of law.

• **Respect for privacy and family life and the right to marry:** protects against unnecessary surveillance or intrusion into your life. You have the right to marry and enjoy family relationships.

• **Freedom of thought, religion and belief:** you can believe what you like and practise your religion or beliefs.

• **Free speech and peaceful protest:** you have a right to speak freely and join with others peacefully, to express your views.

• **No discrimination:** everyone's rights are equal. You should not be treated unfairly – because, for example, of your gender, race, disability, sexuality, religion or age.

• **Protection of property:** protects against state interference with your possessions.

• **The right to an education:** means that no child can be denied an education.

• **The right to free elections:** elections must be free and fair.
