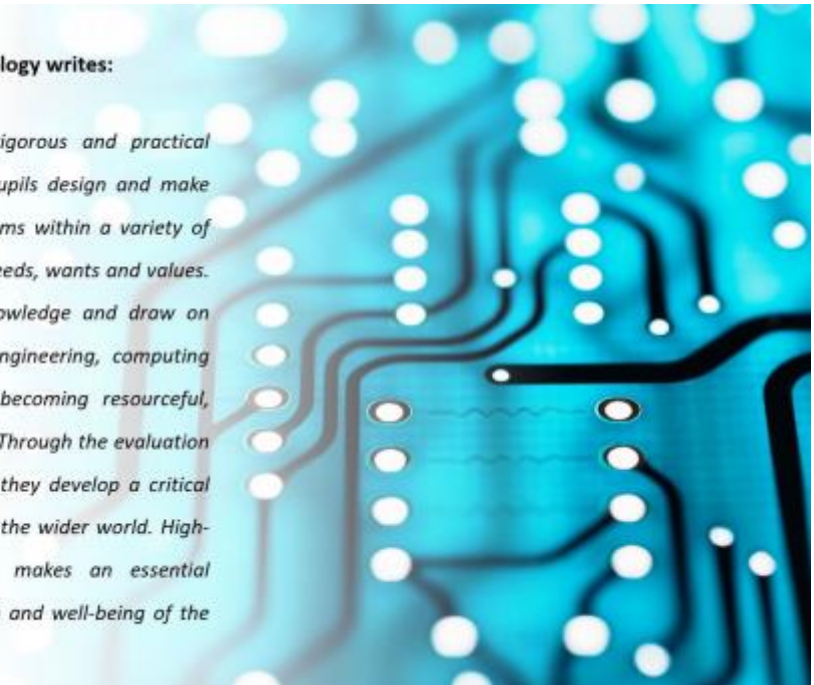



Technology@Park

As we continue to share Park's full school curriculum and learning journeys, this week Design and Technology is in the spotlight.


Miss Lister Curriculum, Leader for technology writes:

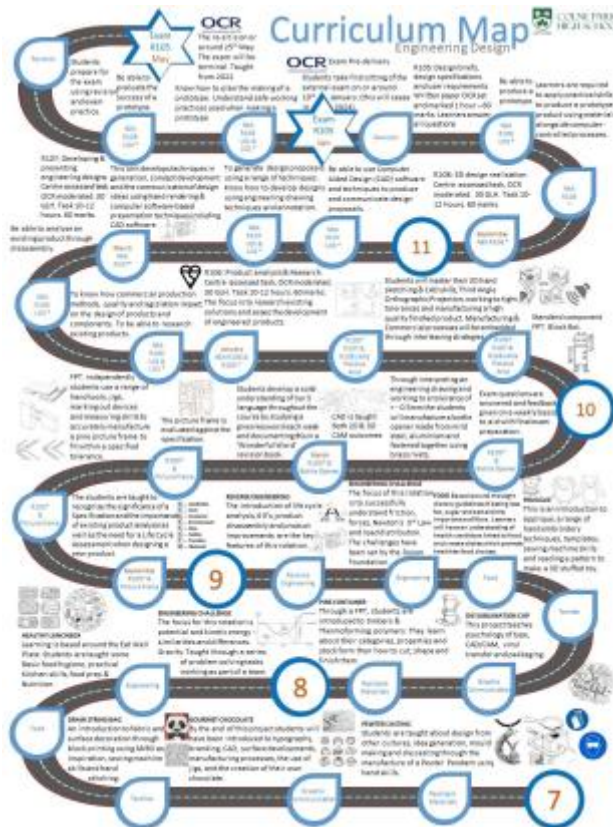

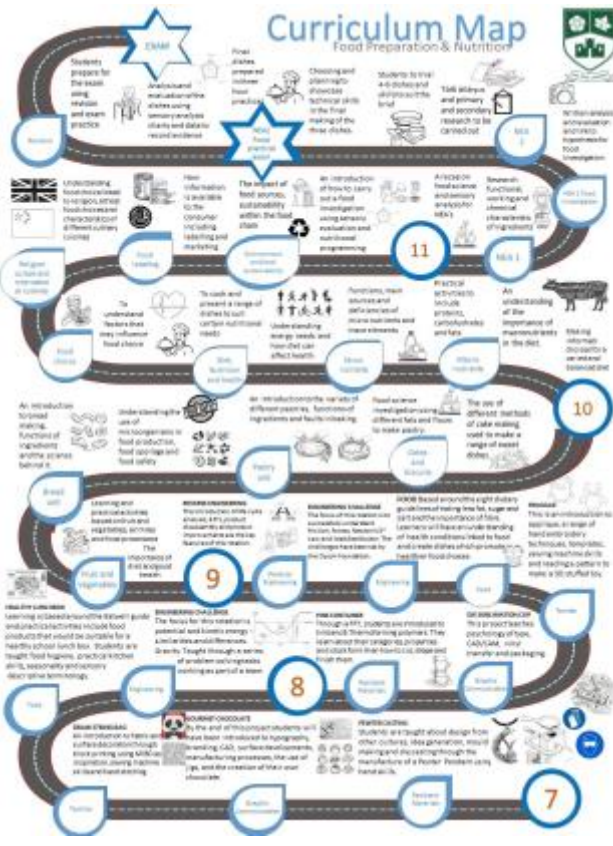
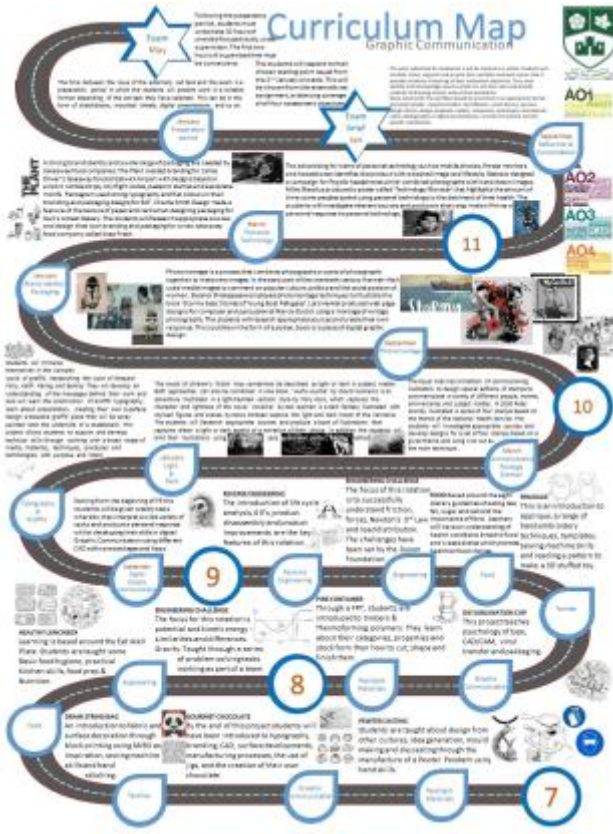
