Just as we looked to be gaining a foot hold in the game a quality ball from the left resulted in a goal putting us 1-0 behind at half time. A couple of adjustments at half time saw Park start the 2nd half well but then a good finish saw St Christophers extend their lead. The boys never gave up and pulled a goal back with 20 minutes to go through Aiden Lister. As we tried to push on the opposition proved to be ruthless on the break and added 2 further goals through some excellent play leaving the final score at 4-1 to St. Christophers as they secured a well deserved victory and our congratulations go to them.

Although the boys were disappointed they could not win the game we are all unbelievably proud of this groups of pupils. They have shown resilience, determination, an unwillingness to give up and a great deal of ability and they have come a long way as a team in their time at Park. They are still only the 2nd team from Park and Pendle to ever reach a Lancashire Cup Final and have created some fabulous memories along the way.
