The fixture was played at AFC Darwen and a good crowd saw a truly excellent game. In the early stages our boys struggled to impose themselves on the game and allowed St. Christophers few chances. Just as we looked to be gaining a foot hold in the game a quality ball from the left resulted in a goal putting us 1-0 behind at half time. A couple of adjustments at half time saw **Park start the 2nd half well** but then a good finish saw St Christophers extend their lead. **The boys never gave up and pulled a goal back with 20 minutes to go through Aiden Lister.** As we tried to push on the opposition proved to be ruthless on the break and added 2 further goals through some excellent play leaving the final score at 4-1 to St. Christophers as they secured a well deserved victory and our congratulations go to them.*

*Although the boys were disappointed they could not win the game **we are all unbelievably proud of this groups of pupils.** They have **shown resilience, determination, an unwillingness to give up and a great deal of ability** and they have come a long way as a team in their time at Park. They are still only the 2nd team from Park and Pendle to ever reach a Lancashire Cup Final and have created **some fabulous memories** along the way.*

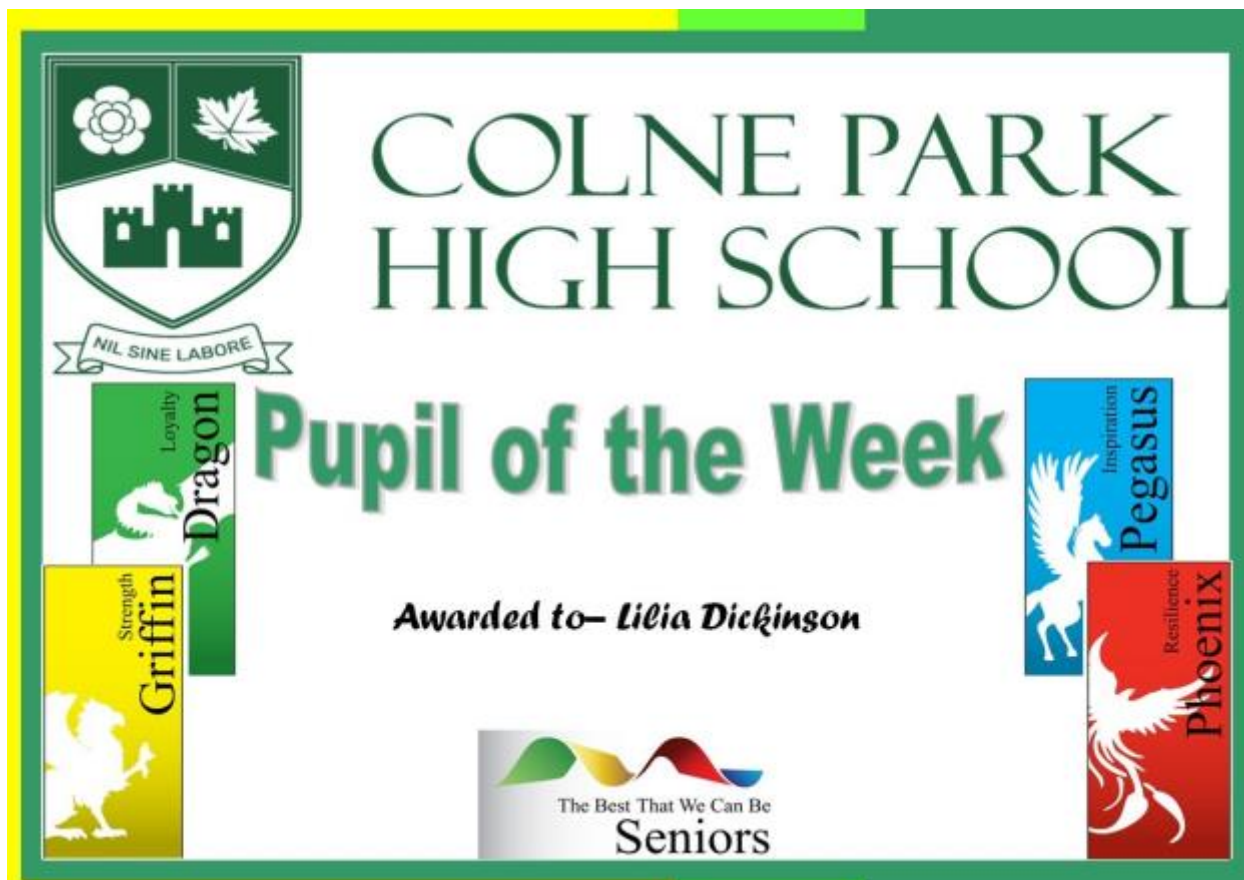
