Year 10 took Yule logs looking fabulous!

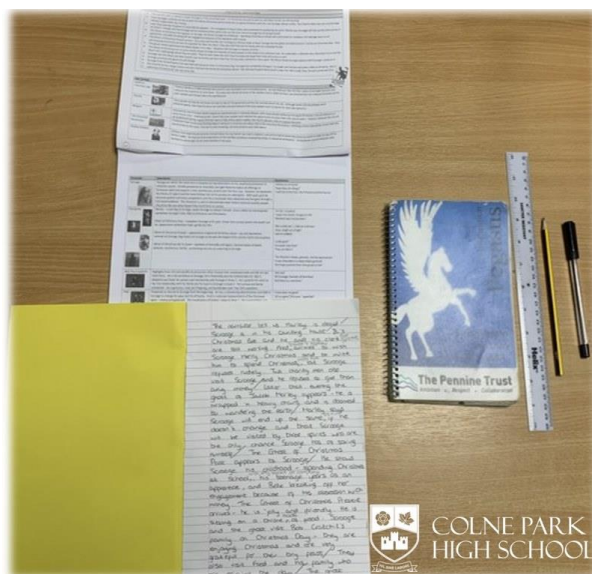
Coated and iced with dark chocolate ganache and filled with a vanilla buttercream before being festively decorated to finish!
