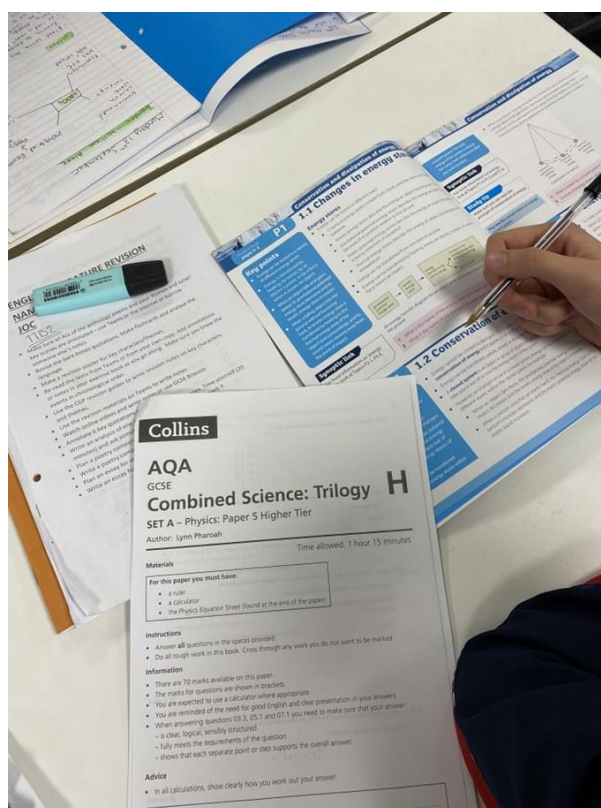

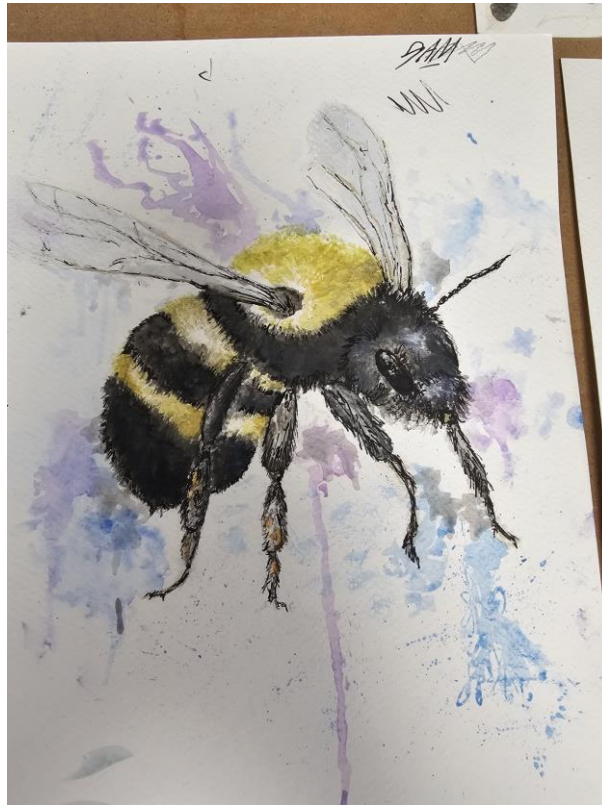
## Walking Talking Mocks Y10- we will be prepared for exam success!
