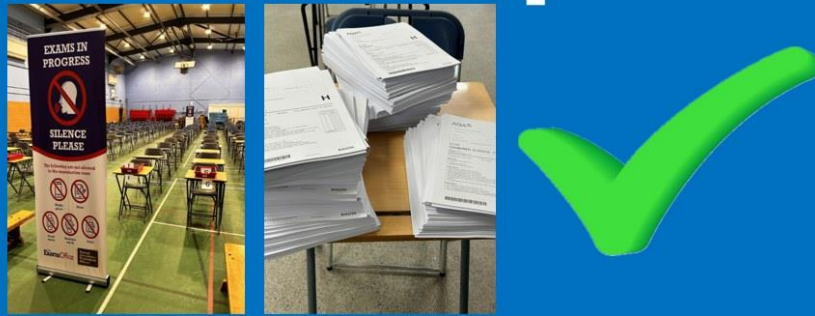


Well done Year 11 Mock Exams week one completed

Until then, keep practising those ski turns and vocal cords for next year's karaoke session! Team Park, you made me so proud of you all".











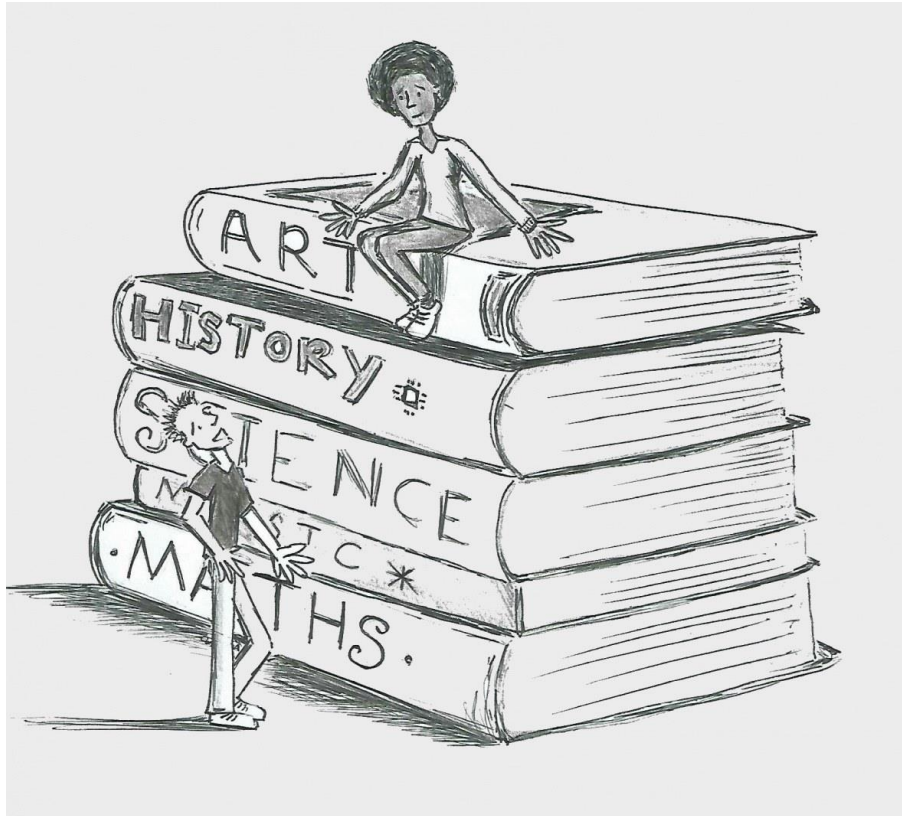




Year 8 Options Evening



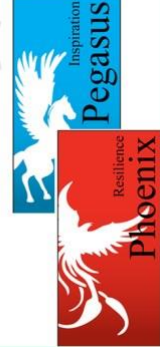
