Year 8 & 9 France Trip July 2025





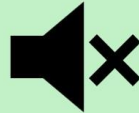
