Huge thanks to Team PE for leading such a fantastic end of year event.





















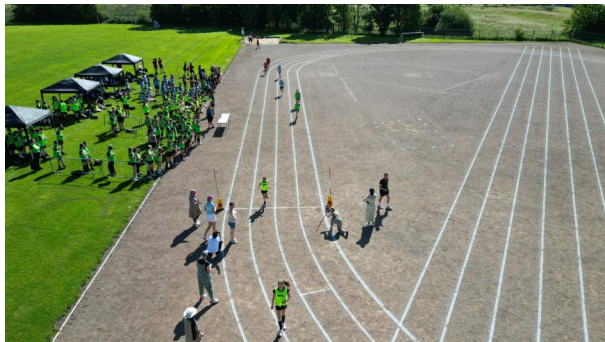


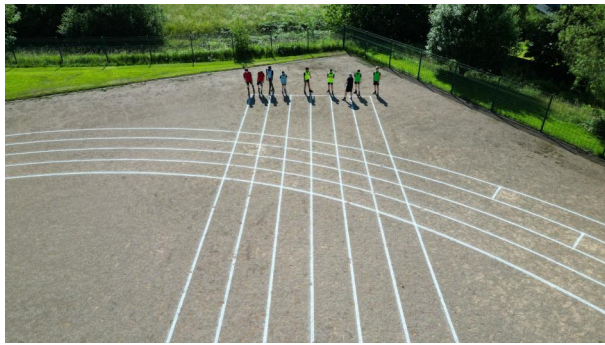
