PD Day 1 - Monday 29th September

We are pleased to announce that the first of our Personal Development days is on the horizon.

Personal Development is an essential part of every students experience at school and plays a pivotal role in preparing students for the opportunities, decisions, responsibilities and experiences of later life.

On Monday 29th September, each year group will take part in a wide range of opportunities to contribute towards their Personal Development.

Year 7: Year 7 will be taking part in workshops, covering the theme of Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural education. The theme for their day is Harvest Festival. Students will be expected to wear full school uniform.

Year 8: Year 8 will be taking part in workshops based upon RSHE. They will be exploring healthy relationships, the PREVENT duty, and keeping themselves safe. Year 8 will be required to wear full school uniform.

Year 9: Year 9 will completing their introduction day to the D of E. They will completing workshops around map reading, first aid and navigation skills. They will also be completing a walk to practise their navigation skills. Students will be required to wear full school **PE kit (warm weather PE kit)**

Year 10: Year 10 will be taking part in workshops based upon RSHE. They will be exploring the themes of Gambling, finance education, addiction and mental health. Year 10 will be required to wear **Full school PE kit.**

Year 11: Year 11 will have a Careers/Post-16 education. They will have workshops with external speakers from local colleges and employers. Alongside this they will be completing

workshops about Email etiquette and social media presence. Students will be required to wear full school uniform.
